Day 1

Sunday 17th May

London Heathrow – Lyon St. Exupery – La Chappelle en Vercors

The group met with Laura and Paul at Lyon St. Exupery Airport, after catching flight BA360 from London Heathrow, Terminal 1. After completing immigration formalities and collecting our luggage, we made our way to the car park, where our vehicles were waiting. With luggage loaded, we set off travelling towards Grenoble, on the A43 and A48. We stopped for our lunch at a motorway rest area, Aire l'Isle d'Abeau. Whilst here, we recorded Starling and Jackdaw, both uncommon species in this area. Common Blue butterfly was also seen. With our lunch complete, we continued on down the A48 towards the outskirts of Grenoble, leaving the motorway to visit the area around Grenoble Isere Airport. The first location produced Kestrel, Marsh Harrier, Red-footed Falcon, Black Kite, Corn Bunting and Skylark. For the plants, the adjacent arable margins revealed *Trifolium incarnatum* subsp. *incarnatum* (Crimson Clover), *Geranium columbinum* (Long-stalked Crane's-bill) and *Lamium garganicum* (Large Red Dead-nettle). Butterflies included Large White, Swallowtail, Grizzled Skipper, Clouded Yellow and Small Skipper, and we also found a Clouded Buff moth. A second stop added the beautiful song of Nightingale and Small White Butterfly.

We now continued on our journey up to the Vercors plateau, via St. Marcellin and Pont en Royans and on via the Petit Goulets and Les Barraques en Vercors, to La Chapelle en Vercors and the Hotel Bellier, our base for the week. After settling into our rooms, and relaxing for a while, several of the group went for a walk, finding *Bunius orientalis* (Warty Cabbage), before it was time to meet with our leaders who outlined the week's programme before for our evening meal.

Day 2

Monday 18th May

Vassieux en Vercors - Font d'Urle – Route Combe Laval

We started the day with a short excursion to Vassieux en Vercors, where we made a short stop at the cemetery where the victims of the Nazi massacre at that village, during the Second World War, are buried. Along a small track we found *Cerastium arvense* (Field Mouse-ear), *Globularia punctata* (Common Globularia) and *Viola tricolor* subsp. *subalpina* (Alpine Heartsease). We also saw Red-backed Shrike, Skylark, Lesser Whitethroat and Linnet.

From here, we moved to a roadside viewpoint above the valley, on the Col de la Chau, with panoramas to the east. *Erinus alpinus* (Fairy Foxglove), *Amelanchier ovalis* (Juneberry) and *Saponaria ocymoides* (Rock Soapwort) were found. Western Bonelli's Warbler was heard and Barn Swallow seen. Orange Tip, Dingy Skipper and Northern Wall Brown butterflies were also recorded together with Hummingbird Hawkmoth.

We now moved to the Font d'Urle, an area of open limestone crags and meadows used for skiing in winter. We began by exploring the slopes adjacent to the car park, on the margins of a snow-patch. It was obvious that fresh snow had fallen here during the previous week. There were many spikes of *Erythronium dens-canis* (Dog-tooth Violet), many of which were in fruit, but some still in flower. There was also *Viola calcarata* (Long-spurred Pansy),

Scilla bifolia (Alpine Squill) and masses of *Crocus vernus* subsp. *albiflorus* (Spring Crocus). A large number of Alpine Choughs were circling above us, and we had distant views of Water Pipit, Red-billed Chough, Northern Wheatear, Griffon Vulture and Black Redstart.

At the edge of other snow-patches, the winter tunnels of Snow Vole were also evident, and as we progressed, we added *Narcissus pseudonarcissus* (Wild Daffodil), *Gentiana verna* (Spring Gentian), *Draba aizoides* (Yellow Whitlow-grass) and *Saxifraga exarata* subsp. *delphinensis* (a Musky Saxifrage), before we returned to the vehicle.

Leaving the Font d'Urle, we made our way through the Forêt Communale de Bouvante, where we set up our picnic, by a stream. During the meal, a solitary Honey Buzzard was seen, flying very high.

We now made our way past the Col de la Machine and along the precipitous Route Combe Laval and on down to St. Jean en Royans, where we visited the supermarket to do the week's picnic shopping. A small meadow produced Common Blue, Small Heath and Small Skipper butterflies and *Erigeron annuus* (Annual Fleabane).

On the return journey, we stopped on a roadside above St Jean, where we found *Orchis purpurea* (Lady Orchid), *Ophrys insectifera* (Fly Orchid) and *Cephalanthera longifolia* (Sword Leaved Helleborine), before moving to the Col de la Machine, where we enjoyed the magnificent scenery. Crag Martin was seen, as well as *Lamium garganicum* (Large Red Dead-nettle), *Kerneria saxatilis* (Kerneria) and *Botrychium lunaria* (Moonwort). We now continued on to La Chapelle.

Day 3

Tuesday 19th May

Col de la Bataille – Col de Bacchus - Gisors

The early bird walk produced superb views of a pair of Crossbills, Whitethroat and Serin.

Today we travelled down towards the Col de la Machine then on over the Col de la Bataille, where we stopped to enjoy the magnificent views in all directions. *Alyssum montanum* (Mountain Alyssum) and *Astragalus depressus* (Sprawling Milk-vetch) were both noted and Song Thrush was heard. Continuing on towards the village of Leoncal, we turned left and headed south through La Vacharie to the Col de Bacchus. Here we stopped to explore a track, broad road verge and adjacent wood, finding *Orchis mascula* (Early Purple Orchid), *Neotinea ustulata* (Burnt Orchid), *Neottia nidus-avis* (Bird's-nest Orchid), *Neotinea tridentata* (Toothed Orchid), in pink and yellow, *Polygonatum odoratum* (Angular Solomon's-seal), *Silene italica* (Italian Catchfly), *Orchis pallens* (Pale-flowered Orchid) and many other species. Down the lane, a Western Bonelli's Warbler was heard. As it was now raining, our leaders elected to move to our furthest destination. So we continued south

We now continued on south through Plan-de-Baix towards Beaufort sur Gervanne. Near Beaufort, we turned west to an area of open scrubby land with marginal woodland, near Gisors, for our lunch stop. Whilst Laura and Paul prepared our picnic, the group began exploring, finding emerging *Limodorum abortivum* (Violet Bird's-nest Orchid), *Helianthemum oelandicum* subsp. *incanum* (Hoary Rockrose), *Quercus pubescens* (Downy Oak) and *Helianthemum apenninum* (White Rock-rose). During the meal, Orange Tip and Common Blue butterflies were active. After eating, we set off to explore further. The group studied the woodland and the scrubby fields, finding *Thymus vulgaris* (Wild Thyme) *Ophrys fuciflora* subsp. *fuciflora* (Late Spider Orchid), *Platanthera bifolia* (Lesser

Butterfly Orchid), *Cephalanthera damasonium* (White Helleborine), *Ophrys scolopax* (Woodcock Orchid) and *Ophrys apifera* (Bee Orchid). We also added Berger's Clouded Yellow, Spotted Fritillary and Green-underside Blue butterflies, and Mother Shipton, Bordered Straw and Burnet Companion moths.

We now moved on to an area of arable fields, nearby. Here, in the past, we had seen Rock Sparrows but, unfortunately, we had no luck. For the botanists, there was *Ranunculus arvensis* (Corn Buttercup), *Vicia orobus* (Upright Vetch) and *Centaurea cyanus* (Cornflower) in the arable margins.

We now began our journey northwards, making a second stop on the Col de Bacchus. Here we added the endemic *Ophrys x flavicans* (formerly *Ophrys drumana*, Drome Bee Orchid), *Astragalus monspessulanus* (Montpelier Milk-vetch), *Orchis simia* (Monkey Orchid) and *Orchis provincialis* (Provence Orchid). A rather distant Griffon Vulture was also seen.

However, shortly after setting off, we found three Red-footed Falcons and a solitary Common Kestrel hunting over the same field. We made a brief comfort stop in Leoncel, before we made our way to the hotel.

Day 4

Wednesday 20th May

Les Merciers - Les Bruyeres – Near Toutre

Today we made our way up to the northern end of the Vercors Plateau. Our main objective was to try to find a Wallcreeper, but we found interesting things en-route, as well. Leaving La Chapelle in low cloud, we drove north through the village of St Martin en Vercors, where we turned off towards the hamlet of Herbouilly. We made our first stop on a verge in the forest to see a stand of *Orchis pallens* (Pale-flowered Orchid). There was also *Lathyrus vernus* (Spring Vetch), *Ribes alpinum* (Mountain Currant) and *Sambucus racemosus* (Red-berried Elder). Firecrest and Song Thrush were both heard.

We continued on to a point just north of Lans en Vercors, to the hamlet of St. Merciers. Parking in a wide quarry-like lay-by, we set off for a tall crag. Laura took the birders to seek out the elusive Wallcreeper, where it had been seen in past years. Settling down on the top of a viewing point to wait and watch for signs of movement, they made themselves comfortable. Meanwhile, Paul took the botanists off to explore. They found *Saxifraga paniculata* (Live-long Saxifrage), *Anthyllis montana* (Mountain Kidney Vetch), *Orchis mascula* (Early Purple Orchid) and masses of *Dactylorhiza sambucina* (Elderflower Orchid), in both the yellow and purple forms and several spikes of *Neotinea ustulata* (Burnt Orchid). Unfortunately, insects were inactive, due to the weather. When we all reconvened, Laura's group had recorded Common Cuckoo, Alpine Swift, Common Swift, Northern Raven and Common Buzzard. Good views were also had of a Tree Pipit and Chamois but, unfortunately, no Wallcreeper.

We now moved down to the southern end of the Gorges du Furon, where we took our picnic in a grassy clearing by the river. Whilst we were there, we added *Adoxa moschatellina* (Moschatel), *Chrysosplenium alternifolium* (Alternate-leaved Golden Saxifrage), *Lamium garganicum* (Large Red Dead-nettle), *Pimpinella major* (Greater Burnet Saxifrage) and *Ficaria verna* (Lesser Celandine). We also heard Common Chiffchaff, and Eurasian Blackcap, and saw Wren.

We now made our way to some wet meadows at Les Bruyeres, where we found *Tephrosieris helenitis* (Swiss Ragwort), *Valeriana dioica* (Marsh Valerian) and *Dactylorhiza majalis* (Broad-leaved Marsh Orchid). A small pond produced a number of Hybrid Edible Frogs. However, the highlight was some fleeting views and calls from a Marsh Warbler, newly arrived and checking out its potential territory. Yellowhammer was heard and Carrion Crow was also added.

It was now time to start our homeward journey, stopping briefly at the abandoned village of Valchevriere, the scene of a battle between the Germans and the Resistance in July 1944. While we were there, Paul demonstrated the leaf characteristics of *Cardamine heptaphylla* (Seven-leaflet Bitter-cress) and *Cardamine pentaphyllos* (Five-leaflet Bitter-cress).

Our final stop of the day was on this quiet road near the hamlet of Tourtre. Robin and Common Buzzard were recorded, as well as seven species of Orchid and *Asarum europaeum* (Asarabacca), before we made our way back to La Chapelle for dinner.

Day 5

Thursday 21st May

Col de Rousset – Chamaloc – Les Nonnieres _ Vallée de Combeau – Cirque d'Archiane

Our first stop today was at the head of the spectacular Col de Rousset – there are truly magnificent views from here. As it was quite chilly, we quickly took some pictures at the Col, before continuing on down the valley, where we made a second stop to watch Griffon Vultures at their roost near Chamaloc. We had scoped views of birds sitting on the crags, and the occasional one in the sky. On the verge banks, the botanists found *Orchis purpurea* (Lady Orchid), *Lotus maritimus* (Dragon's Teeth), *Trifolium campestre* (Hop Trefoil), *Sambucus ebulus* (Dwarf Elder) and *Cotinus coggygria* (Smoke Bush).

By now the weather was beginning to improve, but there was still a chill in the wind. At the bottom of the valley we turned east through the town of Die and on through Pont-de-Quart and Châtillon-en-Diois. We continued on through Menece and up to a point above Les Nonnières, where we parked by some meadows. In some woodland we found a group of emerging *Cypripedium calceolus* (Lady's Slipper Orchid), *Cephalanthera longifolia* (Sword-leaved Helleborine), *Neottia ovata* (Twayblade), *Gentiana angustifolia* (Narrow-leaved Gentian) and *Equisetum telmateia* (Greater Horsetail). Coal Tit was seen and Great Tit, Chaffinch and Chiffchaff were heard. An adjacent verge bank produced a number of magnificent specimens of *Orchis purpurea* (Lady Orchid).

Retracing our route, we turned up into the Vallée de Combeau. Here we made our way up the valley, pausing near the top by a colony *Pinguicula grandiflora* (Large-flowered Butterwort) and *Menyanthes artemisiifolia* (Spiguel). The wind was still very cold and penetrating, and it also started to sleet, so we did not stay too long, but long enough to take pictures of the spectacular Rocher de Combeau. Further down the valley, there was *Arctostaphylos uva-ursi* (Bearberry) and *Orchis spitzelii* (Spitzel's Orchid), one of our target species. The photographers had their second bonanza of the day! The group now made its way into Les Nonnieres, where we took a light lunch and hot drinks, and to get out of the cold wind.

With lunch completed, we set off southwards to the magnificent Cirque d'Archiane, stopping in the valley once again, for photos of the stunning scenery. Black Redstart, Crag Martin and distant, high Griffon Vultures were

seen. Moving back down the valley, we stopped to see *Antirrhinum latifolium* (Broad-leaved Snapdragon), *Anthericum liliastrum* (St. Bernard's Lily) and *Arabis turrata* (Tower-cress) and *Geranium purpureum* (Little Robin).

It was now time to begin the homeward journey, retracing our steps back up towards the Col de Rousset, once again pausing below Chamaloc at the Griffon Vulture roost. This time there were about ten or so birds in the air. We now continued on to La Chapelle en Vercors.

Day 6

Friday 22nd May

Reserve Naturelle des Hauts Plateaux du Vercors

Today, once again, we left the hotel in a southerly direction, making our first stop in a hilly marsh just beyond St. Agnan en Vercors. Here we found *Dactylorhiza alpestris* (Alpine Broad-leaved Marsh Orchid), *Persicaria bistorta* (Bistort), *Narcissus poeticus* (Pheasant's-eye Daffodil) and *Orchis militaris* (Military Orchid).

Moving on down the valley towards Rousset, we turned onto a forest road and made our way up to the car park at La Coche. As we ascended the plateau, we stopped briefly at a viewpoint for photos, where we found *Cardamine heptaphylla* (Seven-leaflet Bitter-cress), *Cardamine pentaphylla* (Five-leaflet Bitter-cress), *Paris quadrifolia* (Herb Paris), *Gymnocarpium robertianum* (Limestone Fern) and *Asplenium viridis* (Green Spleenwort).

Leaving the La Coche car park, wrapped up against a biting wind, we began exploring the mixed coniferous and deciduous woodland and found that *Abies alba* (Silver Fir) and *Picea abies* (Norway Spruce) and *Fagus sylvatica* (Beech) were the predominant trees. Soon after we had left the car park, we found a small group of *Orchis mascula* subsp. *speciosa* (an Early Purple Orchid), and Laura found a Firecrest, Crested Tit, Tree Pipit, Coal Tit and an adult Golden Eagle. Continuing on, the botanists added *Arctostaphylos uva-ursi* (Bearberry), *Dactylorhiza* (*Coeloglossum*) *viride* (Frog Orchid) and *Viola tricolor* subsp. *subalpina* (Alpine Heartsease). As we were arriving at the open plateau, the birders had some clear views of Citril Finch and Dunnock. As we progressed, a few emerging *Daphne cneorum* (Garland Flower), *Potentilla rupestris* (Rock Cinquefoil) and *Ajuga pyramidalata* (Pyramidal Bugle) were added, as well as *Tulipa sylvestris* subsp. *sylvestris* (Wild Tulip), *Narcissus pseudonarcissus* (Wild Daffodil) and *Pinus uncinata* (Mountain Pine). Insects were not at all active, but we did find a Glanville Fritillary at rest.

We set up our picnic in a sheltered clearing near the car park, where Chiffchaff and Chaffinch were heard. After lunch, we rejoined our vehicle for the return journey on the Route Forestiere des Charbonniers (Charcoal-makers route), around the back of the plateau, which afforded great views of the Grand Veymont. As we went, we found several small stands of *Pulsatilla alpina* (Alpine Pasque Flower), as well as *Polystichum lonchitis* (Holly Fern) and much more *Daphne cneorum* (Garland Flower). Making our way off the plateau near the Hamlet of Les Meunieres, we paused to look at a verge bank with a large colony of *Ophrys insectifera* (Fly Orchids). Whilst there, Laura spotted a Short-toed Snake Eagle.

Our final stop of the day was on a verge to the south-east of La Chapelle en Vercors. Here we saw *Neotinea ustulata* (Burnt Orchid), *Ophrys fuciflora* subsp. *fuciflora* (Late Spider Orchid), *Orchis militaris* (Military Orchid) and *Orchis anthropophora* (Man Orchid). There was also *Dianthus carthusianorum* (Carthusian Pink).

Day 7

Saturday 23rd May

Presles – Forêt Domaniale des Coulmes & Pont en Royans

We began today by driving north through the Grand Goulets tunnel and down, via the Petit Goulets, to St. Eulalie en Vercors, where we turned right and continued on through Pont en Royans and up toward the Rocher de Presles, stopping on the Route de Presles. As we climbed a female European Roe Deer crossed the road in front of us. Here, we found *Orchis militaris* (Military Orchid), *Orchis anthropophora* (Man Orchid), *Orchis mascula* (Early Purple Orchid), *Neottia nidus-avis* (Bird's-nest Orchid), *Dactylorhiza fuchsii* (Common Spotted Orchid), *Genista sagittalis* (Winged Pea) and *Melittis melissophyllum* (Bastard Balm). For the birders, there was Chiffchaff, Western Bonelli's Warbler and Blackcap calling, and Common and Alpine Swift seen, but the highlights were a Short-toed Snake Eagle being mobbed by two Common Buzzards and a pair of Red-footed Falcons. Laura also managed to locate a pair of Chamois on a distant pinnacle. Large Wall Brown and Green Hairstreak butterflies were also added.

Moving on, we now stopped at the magnificent Rocher de Presles, a limestone cliff-face overlooking the valley of the River Bourne. Here the birders had sitting Common Buzzard, Black Redstart and House Martins. Western Bonelli's Warbler was also heard. Meanwhile, the botanists added *Prunus mabeleb* (St. Lucie's Cherry), *Anthemis triumfetti* (Southern Dog-daisy) and *Asplenium trichomanes* subsp. *pachyrachis* (Maidenhair Spleenwort).

We now made our way into the Forêt Domaniale des Coulmes, parking at the Fontaine de Pétouze. Here we explored a forest path and adjacent meadows while the leaders prepared lunch. Northern Raven, Coal Tit and Western Bonelli's Warbler were reported, as well as calls from Black Woodpecker. Plants included *Paris quadrifolia* (Herb Paris), *Symphytum tuberosum* (Tuberous Comfrey) and a good number of *Cephalanthera longifolia* (Sword-leaved Helleborine) and *Orchis mascula* (Early Purple Orchid). Whilst we were eating our picnic, Paul pointed out the emerging buds of *Lilium martagon* (Martagon Lily).

After eating, we set off back down the Route de Presles, towards Pont en Royans, where we parked on the outskirts and walked down to Le Picard Restaurant, famous for its ice creams, where we indulged unreservedly. Opposite the café, we watched an adult Dipper and Grey Wagtails, feeding by the river.

Leaving Pont en Royans, we made our way back to La Chapelle en Vercors, with time to pack for tomorrow's homeward journey, and a last dinner of the trip.

Day 8

Sunday 24th May

La Chapelle en Vercors to Lyon St. Exupery – Fly London Heathrow

We left La Chapelle en Vercors at 5am, bidding farewell to Mme. Bellier and her daughters, before making our way via the Grand Goulets Tunnel and Pont en Royans and onto the A49, A48 and A43 motorways to Lyon St. Exupery Airport. En-route we had plenty of time to admire the scenery and spot some birds from the vehicle including Common Buzzard, Black Kite, Honey Buzzard, Grey Heron and Raven. At Lyon, we bid farewell to Monica and John, who were staying on for another week, and to Laura, who was returning to Spain. At Heathrow we said our farewells, and travelled homewards, after a wonderful week in the Vercors.
