Day 1

Wednesday 21st July

Cloudy with showers, becoming fine, warm and sunny later

Christina met Paul at Heathrow for the 8.40am flight to Lyon. Unfortunately, the previous day had seen industrial action by French Air Traffic Control and, subsequently, we were delayed for an hour, arriving at 12-15hrs local time. After passport control and baggage reclaim we made our way out to the arrivals area, where we met with Val and Greg and Nick, who had arrived on the previous day from the UK. We then boarded the bus to the car rental area. As soon as we had completed these formalities we collected our vehicles for the journey to the Vercors region.

We drove westwards on the A43 Motorway, stopping for refreshments at the L'Isle D'Abeau service area. Whilst enjoying lunch we spotted Hummingbird Hawkmoth, Clouded Yellow butterfly and a juvenile Common Wall Lizard. From here, we moved on towards the Grenoble, Isere regional airport, where we explored the lanes and fields to the east and west of the airport. As we approached the site, we saw a single male Montague's Harrier hunting the verges of the road. We stopped on a quiet roadside and began to scan the sky. Kestrel, Common Buzzard and Corn Bunting were all seen. We also saw Great Banded Grayling and a pair of Marbled Skipper butterflies. Many of the arable fields had been harvested, but there were still a few plants to see, including *Allium oleraceum* (Field Garlic), *Verbena officinalis* (Vervain) and *Ambrosia artemisiifolia* (Ragweed). It was now time to continue on south to Grenoble and Sessenage, where we turned up onto the Vercors Plateau. Just after we rejoined the motorway, we saw four Black Kites circling above. It was not long before we arrived in Lans en Vercors and the Hotel Le Val Fleuri, our base for the rest of the tour. Here we were met by our hosts, Eliane Bonnard and her husband, Francois.

Day 2

Thursday 22nd July

Fine, warm & sunny, with rain later

Following a splendid breakfast, we made the short journey to the small hamlet of Les Merciers. Here we explored a steep path, rocky lane sides and some meadows. Our first find of the day was two spikes of *Cephalanthera rubra* (Red Helleborine), followed swiftly by *Asplenium viride* (Green Speenwort), *Clinopodium vulgare* (Wild Basil) and *Epipactis atrorubens* (Dark Red Helleborine). A Gull Bunting was heard calling and several species of butterfly were beginning to wake up. These included Heath Fritillary and Large White. We now retraced our steps and continued our exploration of the rocky lane side. This produced *Dianthus carthusianorum* (Carthusian Pink), *Saxifraga paniculata* (Live-long Saxifrage) and *Orchis ustulata* (Burnt Orchid). Apollo, Spotted Fritillary and Damon Blue were just three of the butterfly species seen. This led us nicely into a meadow situated above a deep gorge. This was fairly dry, but still contained *Gentiana cruciata* (Cross Gentian), *Chamaespartium segittale* (Winged Greenweed), *Sedum sexangulare* (Tasteless Stonecrop), *Populus tremula* (Aspen) and *Sorbus aria* (Whitebeam).

By now the warming sun had encouraged more butterflies to become active. These included Osiris Blue, Scotch Argus, Marbled White, Rock Grayling and Large Wall Brown. Common Swift and Crag Martin were also recorded. After a brief stop in Les Geymonds to buy our picnic, we headed up into the forest below Villard de Lans, to a quiet spot near Malaterre where we stopped and prepared our lunch. As we progressed Greg spotted a Short-toed Eagle sitting on an overhead line tower and a circling Honey Buzzard. The adjacent woods had *Melampyrum nemorosum* (a Cow-wheat), *Hordehymus europaeus* (Wood Barley), *Calamintha grandiflora* (Large Calamint) and *Digitalis lutea* (Small Yellow Foxglove). Heath Fritillary was also identified. Robin, Coal Tit and Wren were recorded and Arran Brown, Great Banded Grayling, Dusky Grizzled Skipper and Idas Blue butterflies were seen together with Chimney Sweeper and Shaded Broad-bar moths. We left this beautiful spot and made our way back to an area of wetland, streams and a pond at Les Buryeres. Almost as soon as we arrived, the heavens opened. As it was quite late in the day, we made our way back to the hotel, where we began identifying the species we had photographed over some welcome refreshments.

Day 3

Friday 23rd July

Rain at first, becoming fine, hot & sunny with cloud

We began today by making a short stop to the north of Lans en Vercors. Here we found Red-backed Shrike, Stonechat and Kestrel. We also saw *Geranium sylvaticum* (Wood Crane's-bill) and *Verbascum nigrum* (Dark Mullein). From here we made another short drive towards St Nizier du Moucherotte, stopping in the forest. This wonderful example of natural mixed conifer and deciduous woodland is home to a number of special plants, as well as birds. A Wren, Crested Tit and Chaffinch were heard calling in the distance as we arrived. However, it was the Orchids that were to attract most attention. We were particularly seeking the small, eerily white spikes of *Epipogium aphyllum* (Ghost Orchid). The verge by the wood produced *Epipactis microphylla*, *Epipactis atrorubens* (Dark Red Helleborine), *Campanula glomerata* (Clustered Bellflower), *Digitalis lutea* (Small Yellow Foxglove) and *Gymnadenia conopsea* (Fragrant Orchid). We entered the wood in search of the Ghost Orchids, but were unable to find any at first. However, we did find a single spike of *Goodyeara repens* (Creeping Ladies Tresses) and several spikes of *Pyrola media* (Intermediate Wintergreen). A diligent search by the whole group finally produced four plants, two of which were in perfect condition. It would appear that the season is still late, and it may be that these plants may yet appear. Insects here included Osiris Blue butterfly and Silver Y moth.

Once again, we made a brief stop in Les Geymonds to buy our picnic, before descending the spectacular Gorges de la Bourne on our way to a picnic site just south of St Julien-en Vercors. During lunch, another Red-backed Shrike and Common Swifts were very much in evidence.

Moving on, we passed through the village of La Chapelle en Vercors, turning west towards Vassieux, before turning up to the Col de la Chau (1337m). Here we made a brief stop to admire the distant peak of the Grand Veymont, which at 2341metres, is the highest peak in the Vercors. While we were stopped, we saw Honey Buzzard, Peregrine Falcon and Kestrel, as well as Great Sooty Satyr and Apollo butterflies.

Our objective for the afternoon was the Font d'Urle (1500m), a ski station with limestone outcrops and meadows. As we approached the parking area we found five Griffon Vultures circling on thermals. Early on, we had close views of Alpine Marmot in the distance and Linnets and Water Pipit were feeding among the rocks. Plants included *Aster alpina* (Alpine Aster), *Gymnadenia austriaca* var. *gallica* (Black Vanilla Orchid), *Serratula tinctoria* (Saw-wort), *Polystichum lonchitis* (Holly Fern) and *Gypsophila repens* (Alpine Gypsophila).

In addition, Common Brassy Ringlet and Niobe Fritillary were added to the growing butterfly list. We now made our way back over the Col de la Chau, making a short stop at the cemetery, where the victims of the Nazi massacre at Vassieux during the Second World War are buried, before driving north to La Chapelle, where we took dinner at the Hotel Bellier, before returning to our hotel.

Day 4

Saturday 24th July

Fine and sunny with a chilly wind

Today's objective was to explore the Route Forestal de la Molière, east of Autrans. The area comprises mixed woodland, open rides, rocky banks and open meadows. Leaving Lans en Vercors, we took the road up towards the towns of Meaudre and Autrans, turning off onto the forest road. Our first stop was on a wide ride, where we found *Veronica urticifolia* (Nettle-leaved Speedwell), *Epipactis helleborine* (Broad-leaved Helleborine) and *Millium effusum* (Wood Millet). Common Buzzard was seen and Wren and Crossbill heard. Insects included Titania's Fritillary, Black-veined White and Almond-eyed Ringlet butterflies and a splendid Water Betony moth caterpillar.

Our next stop was a sloping wet meadow below the road. As we parked, Nick noticed *Epipactis atrorubens* (Dark Red Helleborine) and the last remaining flowers of *Traunsteinera globosa* (Round-headed orchid) on the bank above the road. In the meadow we added *Gymnadenia conopsea subsp. densiflora* (Marsh Fragrant Orchid) and also found Transparent Burnet Moth and the curious Forest Bug.

We took lunch at the Refuge des Feneys, in the midst of several tall specimens of *Gentiana lutea* (Great Yellow Gentian), and Christina's eye was caught by some prolific epiphytic Lichens on an adjacent *Picea abies* (Norway Spruce). Driving on, we made a stop on the broad car park to the ski lift at La Grande Boya. We explored the verge, and birds seen or heard included Coal Tit, Great Tit and Mistle Thrush. We also found Shaded Broad-bar moth. Plants included *Fragaria vesca* (Wild Strawberry), which proved particularly popular! We also saw *Senecio nemorensis subsp. fuchsii* (Wood Ragwort) and *Calamintha grandiflora* (Large Calamint). Some adjacent grassland was also quite interesting, adding Small Heath to the butterfly list, as well as Wart-biter and Dark Bush Crickets.

From here, we moved on through the town of Autrans, stopping in Meaudre for coffee and ice-creams, before continuing. We drove down through the Gorges du Meaudret to Les Jarrards. Here we stopped to explore the River Bourne. Dipper, Grey Wagtail and Black Redstart were seen and we added Marbled Fritillary and Comma to the butterfly list. The river bank produced *Sparganium erectum* (Branched Bur-reed), *Galeopsis bifida* (Common Hemp-nettle) and *Cirsium montanum*, as well as a resting Cream-spot Tiger moth. It was now time to make our way back to the hotel in time for dinner.

Day 5

Sunday 25th July

Weather: fine, hot & sunny with some cloud

After breakfast, we left the hotel and drove south once again through the Gorges de la Bourne., taking the road leading to the South-west. As we made our way down towards Choranche, we stopped on the south side of the Tunnel d'Arbois. Initially, this was to admire this part of the gorge through which the River Bourne flows. However, the old section of tunnel was very wet, and home to many Mosses and Liverworts, which immediately took Christina's interest, and she proceeded to demonstrate a few of these species to us.

Paul also found a Common Frog. Insects included Wall Brown butterfly, Hummingbird Hawk Moth and the curious orange and black Shieldbug, *Graphosoma italicum*. Among the plants seen there were *Blackstonia perfoliata* (Yellow-wort) and *Potentilla caulescens* (Lax Potentilla).

Continuing on to Choranche, we turned west and began to climb up towards the Route de Presles, a magnificent limestone cliff formation, over-looking the Commune de Chatelus and the valley of the River Bourne. Here we saw Alpine Swift, House Martin and Crag Martin as well as Lulworth Skipper, Gatekeeper and Pearly Heath butterflies. Plants included *Rhamnus catharticus* (Common Buckthorn), *Potentilla caulescens* (Lax Potentilla) and *Allium rotundum*. After spending an hour or so exploring, we continued on up through Presles to a picnic site at the Fontaine de Petouze, in the Forêt des Coulmes. During the lunch stop, Meadow Brown, Arran Brown, Silver-washed Fritillary and Scarce Copper butterflies, and Silver-ground Carpet and Brown-line Bright-eye moths were seen. For the plants, *Polygonatum verticillatum* (Whorled Solomon's-seal), *Rhinanthus minor agg* (Common Rattle), *Malva moschata* (Musk Mallow) and *Rosa pendulina* (Alpine Rose) were also recorded. After our picnic, we explore a small man-made pond. Here, we witnessed the mass-emergence of Southern Hawker Dragonflies and a young Grass Snake.

We now made our way back down through Presles and the splendid cliffs of the Route de Presles, and on to Pont en Royans, parking in the town car-park, and walking along the River Bourne into the town, in order to indulge ourselves with a visit to the local ice-cream cafe, while watching a Crag Martins and a Scarce Swallowtail Butterfly. From here, we returned to Lans via the Gorges de la Bourne, stopping at the Pont Rouillard, to explore the river bank *Buddleja* vegetation for more butterflies. We were not disappointed, seeing Great Banded Grayling, Scarce Swallowtail, Cleopatra, Southern White Admiral, Large Skipper and Common Blue in the late afternoon sunshine. We also saw a Dipper on the riverbank and several Swallows collecting insects from the surface of the water.

Day 6

Monday 26th July

Weather: fine, hot & sunny

Today, we returned along the Route Forestal de Moliere, near Autrans, in order to take a walk along the Cretes de la Moliere. Paul had advised us that the car park can be very popular with walkers, so we made our way directly to it. As we parked the vehicles, we became aware of a Firecrest calling, and Coal Tits busy feeding in a nearby *Abies alba* (European Silver Fir). We set off in a southerly direction through mixed woodland containing *Abies alba* (European Silver Fir), *Picea abies* (Spruce), *Fagus sylvestris* (Beech) and *Acer opalus* (Italian Maple). Our route took us along the top edge of an east-facing cliff. It was not long before Val and Greg started to find insects. As we went, Titian's Fritillary, Apollo, Silver-washed Fritillary and Mountain Ringlet Butterflies were recorded. Great Tit, Crested Tit and Goldcrest were all recorded by the birders. Meanwhile, the botanists had found *Cicerbita alpina* (Alpine Sow-thistle), *Campanula rhomboidalis* (a Bellflower), *Silene nutans* (Nottingham Catchfly), *Epilobium alpestre* (Whorled-leaved Willowherb) and *Cotoneaster intergerimus* (Wild Cotoneaster). Several moths were also seen and included, Purple Treble-bar, Six-spot Burnet Moth and Barred Red (Green form)

We continued on for about one and a half kilometres before taking a descending path into the meadows. Lans en Vercors could be seen to the south, and the unmistakable peaks of the Alps, in the east. We now turned north, heading back in the direction from which we had come. The flatter areas of the meadows were grazed by cattle, and were somewhat eutrophic, but the steeper banks leading up to the cliff were botanically richer.

Gentiana lutea (Great Yellow Gentian) and *Cirsium eriophorum* (Woolly Thistle) were common here in the grazed sections. Elsewhere, *Dactylorhiza fuchsii* (Common Spotted Orchid), *Briza media* (Quaking Grass) and *Sideritis hyssopifolia* (Sideritis) were all seen. In this more open habitat, there were Kestrel and Yellow-billed Cough. The meadows produced Wart-biter Crickets, Arran Brown and Brown Argus butterflies. Returning to the vehicles, we enjoyed our picnic under some trees, surrounded by cows.

We now returned to our hotel for a short rest before taking a very early dinner. This was because we were going out later to see if we could find European Beaver. Leaving the hotel, we made our way north to St Nizier du Moucherotte. Here we descended towards Grenoble and on towards Vif, where we were to visit a local reserve where Beaver are known to live. We parked the vehicle, and walked the several hundred yards to the series of lakes where these elusive animal live. It was still quite bright, so we spent time looking at Dragonflies and Damselflies as well as birds. Greg set about showing us some of these delicate creatures. White and Blue Feather-leg damselflies, Beautiful Damoiselle and Scarlet Darter were among them. The birds recorded were, Turtle Dove, Black Redstart and Swallow, and, as it got darker, Nightjar were seen and heard and Scops Owls were calling in the distance. Just as the light was about to go, we were rewarded with a single adult Beaver, seen, at first, grooming by some reeds, and then swimming around the island on which the lodge was situated. When it became too dark to see any more, we made our way back to the hotel.

Day 7

Tuesday 27th July

Weather: fine, hot & sunny

Leaving Lans en Vercors, we once again headed for the Isere Valley at Claix, where we turned south onto the motorway. We continued south to the point where the auto-route ended, at Monestier de Clermont. Here we made our way through the village of St. Paul les Monestier and on to an area of hay meadows. We were hoping for a chance to see and hear Corncrake. Sadly, we were a day or two late, as the farmer had almost completed his haymaking and the birds were no long in residence. In an adjacent set-aside field we found Dark Green fritillary, Mazarine Blue, Large Skipper and Common Blue Butterfly. Grasshopper Warbler was heard and Robin and Blackcap seen.

Moving on, we made our way to Gresse en Vercors, where we drove up the Crete des Alleyrons, with a view to walking up some of the path to the Grand Veymont (2341m). However, we were not permitted to park, so Paul decided to go to another location he knew to be worth visiting, the Par du Serpaton (1588m). We found a nice meadow where we took our picnic, during which time we found *Goodyera repens* (Creeping Ladies Tresses, the seeding heads of *Cypripedium calceolus* (Ladies Slipper Orchid). There was also Spotted Fritillary and 6-spot Burnet Moth. After lunch, we explored the lane margins and rock outcrops adding *Trifolium alpestre*, *Scabiosa lucida* (Shining Scabious), *Himantoglossum hircinum* (Lizard Orchid) and *Campanula rotundifolia* (Harebell). From here, we dropped back down towards Gress en Vercors, stopping to explore the lower section of the footpath at Uclaire. This was quite warm and sheltered, and the butterflies were particularly good with Damon Blue, Apollo, Spotted Fritillary, Meadow Brown and Large Wall Brown. Plants included *Trifolium montanum* (Mountain Clover), *Allium sphaerocephalon* (Round-headed Leek), *Cephalaria alpina* (Alpine Scabious) and *Serratula tinctoria* (Saw-wort). It was now time to make our way back to the motorway and up to Lans. As the sun was now dipping in the sky, we made a final visit to the *Epipogium aphyllum* (Ghost Orchid) to ensure the photographers all had good photos.

Day 8

Wednesday 28th July

Weather: fine, hot & sunny in Lyon & London

We said goodbye to our host Mme. Bonnard and her husband Francois, and began our journey back to Lyon. We retraced the route north that we had used on arrival. Along the way we saw Black Kite, Grey Wagtail and Grey Heron. We arrived at Lyon St. Exupery Airport in good time for our flight back to the UK.
