Day 1

Sunday 15th May

Weather: Cloudy for most of the day, and heavy rain in Lyon & Grenoble

Eleven tour participants met Paul and Alan at St. Pancras International Station for the 08-57hrs Eurostar service to Lille Europe, arriving at 11.24hrs local time. We then transferred to the 12-05hrs Lille to Marseilles TGV service, arriving at Lyon Part Dieu at 15-01hrs. Despite the train being a high-speed service, it was still possible to observe wildlife as we travelled south; although it was not always possible to get the whole group onto sightings. However, birds seen included Red Kite, Common Buzzard, Marsh Harrier, Common Tern and a solitary Cormorant.

Once we arrived at Lyon Part Dieu, we made our way to the Europcar desk, where Paul and Alan completed the formalities, and we collected our minibuses for the final leg of the journey to the Vercors region. Travelling towards Grenoble, we made a short detour to seek out some birds around the margins of Grenoble Isere Airport. Here we found Northern Harrier (Hen Harrier), Black Kite, Western Bonelli's Warbler, Sardinian Warbler, Willow Warbler, Corn Bunting and Common Stonechat among others.

From here we continued on south to Grenoble, before turning up onto the Vercors Plateau. We made our way to Sassenage and continued through Lans en Vercors. We had planned to go through the stunning Gorges de la Bourne, but unfortunately this route was closed to vehicles, necessitating a picturesque, but long-winded diversion. Our destination, the Hotel Bellier in the quiet town of La Chapelle en Vercors, was soon reached. This was to be our base for the next seven nights. After settling into our rooms, it was time to meet for dinner.

Day 2

Monday 16th May

Weather: Dry, warm & sunny with a cold wind where exposed

We began today with a short excursion to Vassieux en Vercors, where we made a short stop at the cemetery where the victims of the Nazi massacre at Vassieux, during the Second World War are buried, before driving up towards the Col de la Chau. While we were there we saw Skylark, Linnet and Yellowhammer in the small quarry. *Cerastium arvense* (Field Mouse-ear) and *Viola tricolor subsp. subalpina* (Alpine Heartsease) were also recorded.

A short stop was made on the way up to the Col de la Chau to look down into the valley and across towards the Hauts Plateaux, and the Grand Veymont, which, at 2341m, is the highest point in the region. *Saponaria ocymoides* (Rock Soapwort), *Amelanchier ovalis* (Juneberry), *Erinus alpinus* (Fairy Foxglove) and *Lactuca perennis* (Blue Lettuce) were all seen. A superb, freshly emerged Apollo butterfly entertained us, as well as Pearl Bordered Fritillary. Overhead, a solitary Raven and a flock of Alpine Chough were spotted on a distant hillside.

From here we made our way over the Col de la Chau and on to Font d'Urle, an area of open limestone crags and meadows used for skiing in winter. We began by exploring some slopes adjacent to the car park. These produced many spikes of *Dactylorhiza sambucina* (Elder-flowered Orchid), and lots of fruiting *Erythronium dens-canis* (Dog-tooth Violet). The flock of Alpine Chough was now circling above us, watching our every move. Northern Wheatear and Water Pipit were also present, struggling to fly against the strong wind. As we moved towards the viewpoint we added *Narcissus poeticus* (Peasants Eye Daffodil) and *Gentiana clusii* (Clusius's Gentian) and we had a number of wonderful encounters with Alpine Marmots. As we neared the viewpoint, *Gentiana verna* (Spring Gentian), *Tulipa sylvestris subsp. sylvestris* (Wild Tulip) and *Saxifraga oppositifolia* (Purple Saxifrage) were added before we were returned to the vehicles.

Lunch was taken in the Forêt de Beuvante, a little way west of the Font d'Urle. During the meal we recorded *Polystichum lonchitis* (Holly Fern), *Euphorbia amygdaloides* (Wood Spurge), *Galium odoratum* (Woodruff) and the leaves of *Isopyrum thalictroides* (Isopyrum). We also saw several Orange Tip butterflies and two species of Longhorn Beetle.

We now continued on through Lente and the spectacular Route de Combe Laval, on our way to St Jean en Royan to shop for the rest of the week's lunches, before returning to La Chapelle. On the return journey, we stopped at spectacular Col de la Machine, where we enjoyed the views looking down the Combe Laval. House Martin and Crag Martin were seen, and we also found a Bloody-nosed Beetle.

Day 3

Tuesday 17th May

Weather: Fine, warm and sunny

For the 'early-birders' a pre-breakfast walk with Alan proved productive. Sightings included Blackcap, Common Redstart, Black Redstart, Serin and White Wagtail. Also Cuckoo and Green Woodpecker were heard.

It was time for a change of direction today, and we began by driving south from La Chapelle en Vercors, making a first stop just south of St Agnan en Vercors to explore the verges and adjacent meadows.

In a wet flush we found *Dactylorhiza alpestris* (Broad-leaved Marsh Orchid) and *Coeloglossum viride* (Frog Orchid), *Phyteuma nigra* (Black Rampion) and *Persicaria bistorta* (Bistort). For the birders, there were Great Tit, Chaffinch and Carrion Crow. We also found an iridescent Chrysomelid leaf beetle, *Chrysocephalus sericeus*.

Moving on, we made our way up on to the Reserve Naturelle des Hauts Plateaux, stopping briefly at a viewpoint, where Paul pointed out the differences between *Cardamine heptaphylla* (Seven-leaflet Bitter-cress) and *Cardamine pentaphyllos* (Five-leaflet Bitter-cress). We also found *Paris quadrifolia* (Herb Paris), *Convallaria majalis* (Lily-of-the-Valley) and hybrid *Sorbus* (Whitebeam). The birds included a singing Song Thrush and splendid views of Coal Tit.

After parking at the La Coche car park, we made our way along the roads and tracks through the forest towards the open area higher up. Good numbers of *Orchis ovalis* (an Early Purple Orchid) were seen, as well as *Daphne cneorum* (Garland Flower), *Tulipa sylvestris subsp. sylvestris* (Wild Tulip) and *Pulsatilla alpestre* (Alpine Pasque Flower).

We then began exploring the mixed coniferous and deciduous woodland and found that *Abies alba* (Silver Fir) and *Picea abies* (Norway Spruce) were the predominant trees. We had some splendid view of Tree Pipit soon after we left the car park. Insect species were well represented, with a particularly good range of butterflies including Swallowtail, Pearl-bordered Fritillary, Green Hairstreak, Berger's Clouded Yellow and Little Blue. We also found animal droppings with five butterfly species on them; Grizzled Skipper, Dingy Skipper, Mazarine Blue, Rosy Grizzled Skipper and Small Tortoiseshell. Also recorded were Broad-bordered and Narrow-bordered Bee Hawk-moths, Common Heath, Burnet Companion and Tau Emperor moths, Glow-worm and Forest Bug. Bird life was quite quiet but Robin and Chiffchaff were fairly frequent and Black Woodpecker was heard. It was not too long before we emerged from the rocky forest onto the plateau, finding *Pinus uncinata* (Mountain Pine), *Arctostaphylos uva-ursi* (Bearberry) and *Potentilla rupestris* (Rock Cinquefoil). Several Black Mountain Moths were flitting along the path and a fine Short-toed Eagle was also seen.

From here we made our way back down to La Coche for lunch. On the way down we heard a single Firecrest, but sadly, could not see it. As we were packing up after lunch, we added a single specimen of Queen of Spain Fritillary to the insect list, and saw a Short-toed Treecreeper. In the afternoon we travelled along the east side of the Plateau, stopping to photograph the Grand Veymont, where we saw another pair of Short-toed Eagles. Returning to the hotel by a different route, we stopped on a quiet road, near Les Meunieres, to admire a verge with a fine stand of *Orchis anthropophora* (Man Orchid), *Ophrys insectifera* (Fly Orchid) and *Cephalanthera longifolia* (Sword-leaved Helleborine).

Day 4

Wednesday 18th May

Weather: Fine, warm and sunny. Heavy rain in the late afternoon

Our first stop today was at the head of the spectacular Col de Rousset – there are truly magnificent views from here. We scanned the adjacent slopes looking for ungulates, but, unfortunately, we were unlucky. Raven and a fine male Blackcap were seen, and around our feet there were good numbers of *Artemisia absinthium* (Wormwood) plants. Among the rocks we found *Kernera saxatile* (Kernera), *Anthyllis montana* (Mountain Kidney Vetch) and *Rhamnus alpinus* (Alpine Buckthorn).

Moving on down the valley, we made a second stop to watch Griffon Vultures at their roost near Chamaloc, seeing about nine birds in total. We located some sitting birds, and observed them in the telescope, and everyone was able to see them. On the verge there were three or four large plants of *Ononis speciosus* (Shrubby Restharrow) and *Cotinus coggygia* (Smoke Bush). Western Bonelli's Warbler was seen, and a fine specimen of Provencal Fritillary.

At the bottom of the valley we turned east through the town of Die and on through Pont de Quart and Chatillon en Diois, and on through Menee and up to Les Nonniaires, where we parked by some splendid meadows. Here, in the woods we found a good stand of *Cypripedium calceolus* (Lady's Slipper Orchid), *Cephalanthera longifolia* (Sword-leaved Helleborine) and *Gentiana angustifolia* (Narrow-leaved Gentian). The adjacent meadow was an absolute riot of colour with *Salvia pratensis* (Meadow Clary), *Leucanthemum vulgare* (Ox-eye Daisy), and *Thymus pulegioides* (Common Thyme) among them. All around there was the singing of Field Crickets, and we also found Mazarine Blue and Almond-eyed Ringlet butterflies, Burnet Companion and Mother Shipton moths and a Wart-biter Cricket nymph.

We now moved down to the Vallee de Combau and found our way through a ford in a small mountain stream to set up lunch under *Pinus uncinata* (Mountain Pine). There was a fine stand of *Pinguicula grandiflora* (Greater Butterwort) and *Scrophularia canina subsp. hoppii* (Alpine Figwort), and we also saw Northern Wall Brown and Small Heath Butterflies together with Bullfinch and Chaffinch. After lunch we stopped to admire a single spike of *Orchis spitzelii* (Spitzel's Orchid), as well as *Meum athamanticum* (Spignel), *Arctostaphylos uva-ursi* (Bearberry) and *Gentiana angustifolia* (Narrow-leaved Gentian).

We then moved on to the village of Menee, where we turned north and up into the Cirque d'Archiane, a splendid amphitheatre of towering rock faces and cliffs. Here we stopped to have some well-earned refreshments in the warm afternoon sun. *Antirrhinum latifolium* (Broad-leaved Snapdragon) and *Arabis turrita* (Tower Mustard) were recorded as well as Transparent Burnet Moth and Common Wall Lizard. Retracing our steps back up towards the Col de Rousset, in what had now become very heavy rain, we continued our journey back to La Chapelle en Vercors for dinner.

Day 5

Thursday 19th May

Weather: Fine, warm and cloudy with some light rain later

Another pre-breakfast walk around the village produced good views of many of the birds we were becoming familiar with including Serin and Common and Black Redstarts.

Today we made our way up to the northern end of the Vercors Plateau. Our main objective was to try and find a Wallcreeper, but we found interesting things en route, too. Leaving La Chapelle, we drove north to the village of St Martin en Vercors. Just north of Les Barques en Vercors, we stopped to admire a bank of *Aquilegia atrata* (Dark Columbine) and *Ranunculus aconitifolius* (Aconite-leaved Buttercup), before moving on, turning right, up towards Herbouilly. We made a short stop at the derelict village of Valchevriere, the scene of another battle between the Germans and the French Resistance in World War Two.

We continued driving on the back road to Villard de Lans, and on through Lans en Vercors to Les Merciers, where we parked in a wide quarry-like lay-by. Setting off for a tall crag, Alan took the birders to seek out Wallcreepers, where they had been seen in past years. Settling down on the top of a viewing point to wait and watch for signs of movement, they made themselves comfortable. Meanwhile, Paul took the botanists off to explore. They found *Cuscuta europaea* (Greater Dodder), *Saxifraga paniculata* (Live-long Saxifrage), *Anthyllis montana* (Mountain Kidney Vetch) and *Saxifraga rotundifolia* (Round-leaved Saxifrage). They also saw Adonis Blue, Small Heath and a roosting Apollo butterfly. When we all reconvened, it was evident that everyone had had a good morning, since, although the Wallcreeper had remained elusive, a pair of Chamois was seen, and a splendid Booted Eagle, spotted from above as it moved below the rock stack, together with Crag Martin and Jackdaw. As we made our way back to the vehicles, Roy spotted a Meadow Fritillary.

We now moved down to the southern end of the Gorges du Furon, where we took our picnic in a grassy clearing by the river. Whilst we were eating we added Wood White, Orange Tip and Small Heath butterflies and heard Chiffchaff, Wren and Chaffinch. Some of the group also saw a Firecrest. Also recorded were Small Yellow Under-wing moth and a Pine Weevil.

After lunch, we left for some wet meadows at Les Bruyeres and we found Black Redstart, Goldfinch and Carrion Crow. Also Grey Heron and Common Buzzard drifted lazily overhead. Plants included *Tephrosia helanitis* (Swiss Ragwort), *Valeriana dioica* (Marsh valerian) and *Dactylorhiza majalis* (Broad-leaved Marsh Orchid). We also recorded Forester, Mother Shipton, Burnet Companion and Latticed Heath moths.

Retracing our route from the morning, we made a final stop on a quiet road verge near the hamlet of Toutre, adding *Ophrys fuciflora* (Late Spider Orchid), *Platanthera bifolia* (Lesser Butterfly Orchid) and *Asarum europaea* (Asarabacca) before making our way back to La Chapelle for dinner.

Day 6

Friday 20th May

Weather: Fine, warm and sunny with light rain later

Today we travelled down towards the Col de la Machine then on over the Col de la Bataille. Here we made a stop to admire the wonderful views. *Lunaria redivida* (Perennial Honesty) and *Alyssum montanum* (Mountain Alison) were seen and a solitary Raven and Common Buzzard. However the highlight was the spectacle of a hundred or so recently emerged Clouded Apollo butterflies that took our attention.

Continuing on over the Col, we dropped down towards the town of Leoncal, where we turned left and headed south through La Vacharie to the Col de Bacchus. Here we stopped to explore a broad road verge and adjacent wood, finding *Orchis mascula* (Early Purple Orchid), *Orchis ustulata* (Burnt Orchid), *Neottia nidus-avis* (Bird's-nest Orchid), *Orchis tridentata* (Toothed Orchid) and *Cephalanthera damasonium* (White Helleborine), among many other species. Western Bonelli's Warbler was seen and Song Thrush and Chiffchaff heard. Mother Shipton and Burnet Companion Moths and Brown Argus, Queen of Spain Fritillary and Green Underside Blue butterflies were also recorded. An extremely obliging Firecrest provided the whole group with very good views of this normally elusive bird.

From here we carried on south through Pain de Baix and Beaufort sur Gervanne, where we turned west to an area of open scrubby land with marginal woodland for our lunch stop. Here we added *Limadurum abortivum* (Violet Bird's-nest Orchid), *Helianthemum oelandicum* subsp. *canum* (Hoary Rockrose), *Ophrys drumana* (Drome Orchid) and *Quercus pubescens* (Downy Oak) to the plant list, and we added Adonis Blue, Chalkhill Blue, Yellow-banded Skipper, Spotted Fritillary and Black-veined White to the butterfly list and Feathered Footman, Lewes Wave, Lace Border and Rush Veneer to the moth list as well. In some adjacent *Thymus vulgaris* (Wild Thyme) grassland we added *Ophrys apifera* (Bee Orchid), *Ophrys fuciflora* (Late Spider Orchid) and *Ophrys scolopax* (Woodcock Orchid). Western Bonelli's Warbler and Firecrest were singing all around the lunch spot and a Cuckoo was seen.

After lunch we took a walk out into some scrubby pasture. Here we recorded *Ophrys drumana*, *Helianthemum apenninum* (White Rockrose), *Orchis tridentata* (Toothed Orchid), *Ophrys fuciflora* (Late Spider Orchid) whilst a Black Kite patrolled overhead. At this point we retraced our steps a little, going back towards Beaufort, where we explored some arable margins. There were very good views of Rock Sparrows and Turtle Dove, and an Empusid Mantis and Wartbiter Cricket were also seen. It was now time to head north. Along the way we stopped to look at a *Platanthera bifolia* (Lesser Butterfly Orchid) and as we crossed the Col de la Bataille, a solitary Honey Buzzard drifted over.

Day 7

Saturday 21st May

Weather: Fine, hot and sunny, with a few evening showers

We began today by driving north through the Grand Goulets tunnel and down to St. Eulalie en Vercors, where we turned right and continued on and up to the Rocher de Presles, a magnificent limestone cliff-face overlooking the valley of the River Bourne. At the cliffs we saw a spectacular display by Alpine Swift and Crag Martin, which were wheeling around our heads. We also saw Common Swift, which gave us a chance to compare the two, as well as House Martin and Short-toed Eagle. The plants here included *Anacamptis pyramidalis* (Pyramidal Orchid), *Lactuca perennis* (Mountain Lettuce), *Bupthalmum salicifolia* (Yellow Ox-eye) and *Anthericum liliago* (St. Bernard's Lily). We also added Marbled White, Black-veined White and Six-spot Burnet Moth to the insect list.

After spending some time here, we moved north towards the Forêt domaine des Coulmes, where we parked at the Fontaine de Petouze. We began by exploring the woodland and adjacent grassy glades. Blackcap, Robin, Song Thrush and Chaffinch were all recorded, and, once again, we had very good views of Firecrest. Butterflies were good here too. Black-veined White, Pearl-bordered Fritillary, Sooty Copper and Chequered Skipper were all recorded. Emerging *Lilium martagon* (Martagon Lily), *Paris quadrifolia* (Herb Paris) and *Saxifraga rotundifolia* (Round-leaved Saxifrage) were also seen.

After we completed our picnic under the trees, we set off back down the Route de Presles, pausing to photograph a single *Himantoglossum hircinum* (Lizard Orchid) and a bank of *Ornithogalum pyrenaicum* (Bath Asparagus). From here we made our way into Pont en Royans, where we parked in the public car park by the river and walked into the village. By the river we had good views of Dipper and a pair of Grey Wagtail. We stopped in a local cafe, famous for its Ice Creams, where we all indulged unreservedly. Whilst enjoying the refreshment we were able to watch Crag Martins, some of which perched on a rock ledge. Leaving Pont en Royans, we made our way back to La Chapelle en Vercors.

Day 8

Sunday 22nd May

Weather: Fine, hot and sunny

We left La Chapelle en Vercors at 07-00hrs, bidding farewell to Mdme. Bellier and her daughters, and made our way via the Grand Goulets tunnel to Pont en Royans and then headed east towards Grenoble and then on to Lyon Part Dieu. En route we had plenty of time to admire the scenery and spot some birds from the vehicle including Common Buzzard, Black Kite, Marsh Harrier, Grey Heron and Mute Swan. At Lyon Part Dieu Station the group said farewell to Paul and Alan who were staying to collect another Naturetrek group visiting the Vercors. The group then caught the TGV back to Lille, and then the Eurostar to St. Pancras.
