Day 1

Sunday 14th May

London St. Pancras – Lille Europe – Lyon-Part-Dieu – La Chapelle en Vercors:

Twelve tour participants met Paul and Pete at St. Pancras International Station for the 8.58am Eurostar service to Lille Europe, arriving at 11.30am local time. Following lunch taken in Pub O'Conway's, we then transferred to the 1.03pm Lille Europe to Nice TGV service, arriving at Lyon-Part-Dieu at 4pm. Despite the train being a high-speed service, it was still possible to observe wildlife as we travelled south, although it was not always possible to get the whole group onto sightings. However, birds seen included Common Kestrel, Mute Swan and a female Marsh Harrier.

Once we arrived at Lyon-Part-Dieu, we made our way to where our leaders completed the vehicle hire formalities, and we collected our minibuses for the final leg of the journey to the Vercors region, travelling towards Grenoble on the A43 and A48 motorways, and then onto the A49 Valence motorway which we left at St. Romans. Along the way we saw several Black Kites, Eurasian Jay, Carrion Crow, Common Buzzard and a fleeting glimpse of a Black Woodpecker. We approached the Vercors plateau via Pont-en-Royans, and continued to La Chapelle via the attractive Petit Goulets, arriving at the Bellier Hotel, our base for the week, at 7.15pm. We were met by Celine and her sister Sandra, who quickly allocated our rooms, before we assembled for dinner. We all then retired after a rather long day.

Day 2

Monday 15th May

Fonte d'Urle – Forêt de Bouvante - Route Combe Laval & Col de la Machine

On a clear, bright, but windy morning, we began by pausing near Vassieux en Vercors. We made a short stop at the cemetery where the victims of the Nazi massacre at that village during the Second World War are buried. While we were there, sightings included Barn Swallow and a solitary Raven. In the area behind the cemetery which, until 2012, had been a small quarry, *Globularia punctata* (Common Globularia) was recorded, together with *Cerastium arvense* (Field Mouse-ear) and *Helleborus foetida* (Stinking Hellebore). A short stop was made on the way up to the Col de la Chau to look down into the valley and across towards the Hauts Plateaux, and the Grand Veymont which, at 2,341 metres, is the highest point in the region. Here we found *Erinus alpinus* (Fairy Foxglove), *Amelanchier ovalis* (Juneberry) and *Saponaria ocymoides* (Rock Soapwort) as well as singing Common Chiffchaff, Booted Eagle, a pair of Golden Eagles and several Griffon Vultures. Two butterflies, Northern Wall Brown and Adonis Blue were seen, as well as Speckled Yellow moth.

We now moved up to the Font d'Urle, an area of open limestone crags and meadows used for skiing in winter. As we arrived, a roadside bank was examined, and a small colony of *Soldanella alpina* (Alpine Snowbell) was found, together with *Daphne mezereum* (Mezereon) and *Ranunculus kuepferi* (Kuepfer's Buttercup). Parking the vehicles at the refuge, we set off to explore, finding *Crocus caeruleus* (White Crocus), in both purple and white colour forms, good numbers of *Erythronium dens-canis* (Dog-tooth Violet) and both colour forms of *Dactylorhiza sambucina* (Elder-flowered Orchid). A flock of Alpine Chough were ever present and several Water Pipits, Black Redstart and occasional Northern Wheatear were also recorded. As we moved towards the viewpoint we added *Narissus pseudonarcissus* (Wild Daffodil), *Gentiana verna* (Spring Gentian), *Draba aizoides* (Yellow Whitlow-grass)

and *Thlaspi montana* (Mountain Penny-cress). Along the way we had clear, but rather distant, views of Alpine Marmots. As we neared the viewpoint, *Scilla bifolia* (Alpine Squill) was added, together with *Saxifraga oppositifolia* (Purple Saxifrage) and *Pulmonaria montanum* (Mountain Lungwort). Due to the wind, butterflies were not active, although Grizzled Skipper was reported, and also Mother Shipton moth. It was now time to return to the vehicles, and move to our lunch spot.

Lunch was taken in the Forêt Communale de Bouvante, a little way west of the Font d'Urle. During our meal, Coal Tit and Wren were added. Plants included *Cardamine heptaphylla* (Seven-leaflet Bittercress), *Galium odoratum* (Sweet Woodruff) and *Paris quadrifolia* (Herb-Paris). We now continued on through Lente to the Col de la Machine, where we paused to admire the magnificent views. We then passed through the spectacular Route de Combe Laval, on our way to St-Jean-en-Royans to shop for the rest of the week's lunches, before returning to La Chapelle. By now, at this lower altitude, the sun was shining, and the temperature was a good number of degrees higher. A rough meadow produced some nice butterflies: Brimstone, Heath Fritillary, Large, Small and Sooty Coppers and Clouded Yellow were all seen before we made our way back to La Chapelle en Vercors.

Day 3

Tuesday 16th May

Chamaloc – Les Nonnières – Vallée de Combeau - Archiane

Our first planned stop was at the head of the spectacular Col de Rousset, from which we had magnificent views from the top of the Col down towards the town of Die. Several Griffon Vultures were soaring and *Anthyllis montana* (Mountain Kidney-vetch) and *Artemisia absinthium* (Wormwood) were also seen. Moving on down the valley, we passed through the pretty village of Chamaloc. On the roadside banks we noted a number of *Orchis purpurea* (Lady Orchid) and the pink bushes of *Ononis fruticosa* (Shrubby Restarrow).

Moving down the valley and through Die, we turned east through Pont-de-Quart and Châtillon-en-Diois, through Menée and up to Les Nonnières, where we parked by some meadows. In the woods, we found *Cypripedium calceolus* (Lady's Slipper Orchid), just coming into flower, *Cephalanthera longifolia* (Sword-leaved Helleborine) and *Gentiana angustifolia* (Narrow-leaved Gentian). On an adjacent verge bank, we found some fine specimens of *Orchis purpurea* (Lady Orchid) together with *Genista sericea* (Silvery Greenweed), and *Lonicera xylosteum* (Fly Honeysuckle). The fine sunny morning meant that insects were rather active, with Wood White, Orange Tip, Brimstone, Common Blue, Small Heath and Escher's Blue all recorded. Field Cricket, together with Latticed Heath, Speckled Yellow, Lewes Wave, Burnet Companion and day-flying grass moths were also seen. Meanwhile, the birders reported Coal Tit, Great Tit and distant Cuckoo.

We now moved down to the Vallon de Combeau, where we made our way up to the head of the valley to a picnic site by a stream. During the meal, there were Berger's Clouded Yellow, Wood White and Orange Tip butterflies in good numbers. In a damp ditch, *Pinguicula grandiflora* (Large-flowered Butterwort) and *Meum athamanticum* (Spignel) were added. We now moved back down the valley in search of *Orchis spitzellii* (Spitzel's Orchid). After a good search, we managed to find two freshly emerging plants on a rocky verge. Here we also had brief views of Common Chiffchaff. This valley has some wonderful scenery, especially the magnificent Rocher de Combeau, and many of the group took the opportunity to take photos.

We now moved back to Les Nonnières, and down to Menée, where we turned up into the Cirque d'Archiane, a splendid amphitheatre of towering rock faces and cliffs, so group members could take some pictures. Butterfly activity was good once again, with Little Blue, Berger's Clouded Yellow, Scarce Swallowtail, Brimstone and Orange Tip all seen, together with a few Griffon Vultures and a Golden Eagle.

It was now time to retrace our steps back to La Chapelle en Vercors.

Day 4

Wednesday 17th May

Reserve Naturelle des Hauts Plateaux du Vercors

After checking the weather forecast, Paul and Pete decided to make this the day for visiting the Hauts Plateaux.

Leaving the hotel after our 8am breakfast, we made a brief stop just outside La Chapelle, on a steep grassy hillside. Here we found *Neotinea ustulata* (Burnt Orchid), *Ophrys fuciflora* subsp. *fuciflora* (Late Spider Orchid), *Ophrys insectifera* (Fly Orchid) and *Orchis anthropophora* (Man Orchid). Moving on southwards, we attempted to make our way up on to the Reserve Naturelle des Hauts Plateaux. Unfortunately, the normal access was closed, so we had to retrace our route back to Les Meunières, and take the alternative route up to the car park at La Coche, where we parked. As we were preparing to set off, a solitary Golden Eagle flew over. We now made our way along the roads and tracks through the forest towards the open area higher up, finding as we went, *Daphne mezereum* (Mezereon), *Ranunculus kuepferi* (Kuepfer's Buttercup), *Pinus uncinata* (Mountain Pine) and *Narcissus pseudonarcissus* (Wild Daffodil). Mistle Thrush and Coal Tit were early bird records. Along the way we saw Swallowtail, Orange Tip, Northern Wall Brown, Grizzled Skipper, Rosy Grizzled Skipper and Dingy Skipper butterflies. On the plateau, *Tulipa sylvestris* subsp. *syvestris* (Wild Tulip), *Potentilla rupestris* (Rock Cinquefoil) and *Polygala alpestris* (Mountain Milkwort) were added, together with Dunnock and European Crested Tit. On the descent, we explored the mixed coniferous and deciduous woodland and found that *Abies alba* (Silver Fir), *Fagus sylvatica* (Beech) and *Picea abies* (Norway Spruce) were the predominant trees. In addition, we added Common Firecrest, Tree Pipit and heard Ring Ouzel. From here we made our way back down to La Coche, where we took lunch.

After lunch, we travelled along the east side of the Plateau, stopping to admire the views across to Le Grand Veymont. Here we found several spikes of *Orchis mascula* subsp. *speciosa* (an Early Purple Orchid). Continuing down to a lower level, below the plateau, where we stopped to examine a long grassy verge bank near Les Meunières. Here we found a substantial stand of *Ophrys insectifera* (Fly Orchid) together with *Orchis anthropophora* (Man Orchid) and *Orchis mascula* (Early Purple Orchid). European Robin was also heard.

We now returned to La Chapelle to freshen up before dinner.

Day 5

Thursday 18th May

Col de la Bataille – Leoncel - Col de Bacchus - Gigors

Today we left La Chapelle, and made our way, once again, towards Lente, and on to the Col de la Bataille, where we made a stop to admire the spectacular scenery. As we went, we noted several Mistle Thrushes and a pair of Bullfinches. Exploring the grassland, plants included *Alyssum montanum* (Mountain Alison), *Centaurea montana*

(Perennial Cornflower) and *Saxifraga tridactylites* (Rue-leaved Saxifrage). For the birders there was Common Buzzard and Common Kestrel, but the highlight was a brief glimpse of a pair of Alpine Ibex.

We now moved on down to Leoncel and south through La Vacharie to the Col de Bacchus. Here we stopped to explore a broad road verge and adjacent wood, finding *Orchis mascula* (Early Purple Orchid), *Neotinea ustulata* (Burnt Orchid), *Dactylorhiza sambucina* (Elder-flowered Orchid) in its yellow colour form, *Orchis simia* (Monkey Orchid), *Anacamptis morio* (Green-winged Orchid), *Silene italica* (Italian Catchfly) and many other species. Down a small track, we added *Lathyrus vernus* (Spring Vetchling), *Orchis pallens* (Pale-flowered Orchid) and emerging *Aquilegia vulgaris* (Columbine). The birders were also getting tantalizing snippets from Cirl Bunting and Western Bonelli's Warbler.

We now continued south through Plan-de-Baix and Beaufort sur Gervanne, where we turned west to an area of open scrubby land with marginal woodland, near Gigors, for our lunch stop. Whilst we prepared our picnic, some of the group heard and saw Western Bonelli's Warbler, and there was a fine stand of *Limodorum abortivum* (Violet Bird's-nest Orchid), *Ophrys × flavicans* (Drome Orchid) and two spikes of *Ophrys scolopax* (Woodcock Orchid).

After eating, we set off to explore the woodland and the scrubby fields, finding *Thymus vulgaris* (Wild Thyme), *Helianthemum oelandicum* subsp. *incanum* (Hoary Rock-rose), *Quercus pubescens* (Downy Oak) and several spikes of *Ophrys insectifera* (Fly Orchid). In addition, there was more *Ophrys × flavicans* (Drome Bee Orchid), *Helianthemum apenninum* (White Rock-rose) and several hybrid Orchids. Butterflies were active, with Provence Chalkhill Blue, Scarce Swallowtail, Green-underside Blue and Small Heath all being recorded. Meanwhile, the birders heard Green Woodpecker and Common Cuckoo, and saw Black Kite.

From here, we moved back to a second site on the Col de Bacchus. Here we recorded the endemic *Ophrys × flavicans* (Drome Bee Orchid), *Astragalus monspessulanus* (Montpellier Milk-vetch), *Orchis simia* (Monkey Orchid), and *Orchis provincialis* (Provence Orchid). Small Blue Butterflies were also much in evidence.

It was now time to head north. Along the way, two Red-backed Shrikes, and Common Buzzard were seen.

Day 6

Friday 19th May

Gorges de la Bourne - Canyons des Écourges – Below the Grand Goulets

We awoke this morning to torrential rain. Nevertheless, following a good breakfast, we were soon on the road.

We travelled up towards the northern end of the Vercors Plateau, making our first stop in the spectacular Gorges de la Bourne, by the Pont de Valchevrière. As soon as we got out of the vehicles, we found a White-throated Dipper searching for breakfast in the river. On the wet cliffs we found *Cystopteris fragilis* (Brittle Bladder-fern), *Saxifraga rotundifolia* (Round-leaved Saxifrage), *Bellidastrum michelii* (False Aster) and *Gymnocarpium robertianum* (Limestone Fern).

Moving on, we made our way through the gorge and up the valley, through Rencurel and over the Col de Romyère and into the Canyons des Écourges, where we parked at the car park. The rain, by now, had eased to a

drizzle, and we walked down to the cliffs to look for Wallcreeper. Both Mistle and Song Thrushes were noted, and we found *Cardamine pentaphyllos* (Five-leaved Bitter-cress), *Primula auricula* (Bear's-ear Primrose) and *Narcissus poeticus* (Pheasant's-eye Daffodil). Grey wagtail was also seen. The birders began scanning the extensive cliffs but, unfortunately, could not locate the Wallcreeper. They did, however, find Crag Martin and House Martin. The botanists went to explore some wet scrubby woodland, near the car park. Here they found *Anemone ranunculoides* (Yellow Anemone), *Chrysosplenium alternifolium* (Alternate-leaved Golden Saxifrage) and *Ranunculus aconitifolius* (Aconite-leaved Buttercup).

By now the rain had all but stopped and the cloud began to break, so we drove into the Forêt Domaniale des Coulmes, parking at the Fontaine de Pétouze. Here we set up our picnic. As we were eating, Song Thrush was heard, and Great Spotted Woodpecker was seen. Paul pointed out *Paris quadrifolia* (Herb-Paris) and the emerging buds of *Lilium martagon* (Martagon Lily).

After eating, we set off back down the Route de Presles, towards Pont-en-Royans, and on through the Petit Goulets, where we parked on a track, and began to explore. The sun was now fully out, and the butterflies were active. Berger's Clouded Yellow, Scarce Swallowtail, Adonis Blue, Wall Brown and the rather restricted Darwin's Heath were all seen. Common Wall Lizards were seen basking and the hybrid Orchid, *Orchis anthropophorum* × *O. simia* (Man crossed with Monkey Orchid) and *Cotinus coggygria* (Smoke Bush) were found.

We now returned to La Chapelle for dinner.

Day 7

Saturday 20th May

Presles – Forêt Domaniale des Coulmes - Pont-en-Royans

We began today, in light rain, by driving north and though the Grand Goulets Tunnel, where the rain eased off, and down to St. Eulalie en Royans. Here we turned up through Pont-en-Royans and up to a point on the Route de Presles, where we parked. As we got out of the vehicles, a flock of 10 or so Alpine Swift and a solitary Booted Eagle were seen. We now set off to explore the small lane going to Courtevoux. Here, we found *Orchis simia* (Monkey Orchid), a good number of *Orchis anthropophora* (Man Orchid), *Phyteuma nigra* (Black Rampion), *Orchis mascula* (Early Purple Orchid), *Cephalanthera longifolia* (Sword-leaved Helleborine), *Dactylorhiza fuchsii* (Common Spotted Orchid) and *Melittis mellissophyllum* (Bastard Balm). For the birders, there was Black Kite and Chiffchaff, Common Cuckoo and Blackcap calling, and butterflies included Small White, Adonis Blue and Wall Brown.

Moving on, we drove through the magnificent Rocher de Presles, a limestone cliff-face overlooking the valley of the River Bourne, and on into the Forêt Domaniale des Coulmes, parking at the Fontaine de Pétouze. Here we explored a nearby meadow, whilst our leaders set up our picnic. *Dactylorhiza sambucina* (Elder-flowered Orchid), *Orchis mascula* (Early Purple Orchid) and *Lonicera xylosteum* (Fly Honeysuckle) were noted. As we were eating, Song Thrush and a distant, drumming Black Woodpecker, were heard.

Retracing our steps, we made a short stop at the Rocher de Presles to admire the stunning views. Common Kestrel, Crag Martin and House Martin were seen, as well as *Coronilla vaginalis* (a Scorpion-vetch), *Erinus alpinus* (Fairy Foxglove) and Wall Brown and Scarce Swallowtail butterflies

Continuing our descent, we set off back down the Route de Presles, towards Pont-en-Royans, where we parked on the outskirts and walked down to Le Picard Restaurant, famous for its ice creams, where we indulged ourselves. Opposite the café, we watched an adult Dipper feeding young, Grey Wagtails, also feeding by the river, and Crag Martins, which were performing particularly well. *Tilia cordata* (Small-leaved Lime) was noted in the gorge, and *Erysimum cheiri* (Wallflower) and *Campanula rotundifolia* (Harebell) on a steep wall.

Leaving Pont-en-Royans, we made our way back to La Chapelle en Vercors, making a brief stop at a road verge bank near Toutre, where we found the curious flowers of *Asarum europaeum* (Asarabacca), *Ophrys fuciflora* (Late Spider Orchid) and heard Blackcap.

It was now time to return to our hotel in time to pack for tomorrow's homeward journey, and a last dinner of the trip.

Day 8

Sunday 21st May

La Chapelle en Vercors – Lyon-Part-Dieu – Lille Europe - London St. Pancras

We left La Chapelle en Vercors at 7.30am, bidding farewell to Mme. Bellier, her daughters and her staff, and made our way via the Gorges de la Bourne, Lans en Vercors and the outskirts of Grenoble, to the motorway A48 Motorway. We then headed north to Lyon-Part-Dieu. En route, we had plenty of time to admire the scenery and spot some birds from the vehicles, including Common Buzzard, Black Kite, White Stork, Grey Heron and Carrion Crow.

At Lyon-Part-Dieu Station, the group said farewell to Paul, who was staying on to collect another Naturetrek group visiting the Vercors. The remainder of the group then caught the TGV back to Lille, and then the Eurostar to St. Pancras.
