The group met at the slipway at Bath Road Car Park, Lymington, at 9.00am. After a short introduction and a discussion of the plan for the day, we headed off along the seawall around Lymington Marshes, taking time to talk about the history of the site as we walked.

The lagoon at Normandy was full of birds. While we were discussing the various wildfowl and waders present, a group of Spoonbills flew in and gracefully landed on the lagoon, giving everyone good views. Along the seawall, we watched a couple of Kingfishers hunting, enjoyed point-blank views of Spotted Redshank, Common Redshank and Greenshank, and were teased by a pair of Dartford Warblers moving through the scrub, alongside a pair of Stonechats. We completed the circular walk with some lovely views of Roe Deer in an adjacent paddock.

We then relocated to Buckler's Hard for the second part of the trip: a cruise along the Beaulieu River out to the Solent and back. Highlights were many and varied. A group of around thirty Cormorants was a constant companion, fishing communally and putting on an impressive display. We also enjoyed fly-over views of Marsh Harrier, and exceptionally close views of a fishing Great Northern Diver; it repeatedly dived to catch and consume crabs from the riverbed. Great views of a pair of Great Black-backed Gulls squabbling over a large dogfish were memorable, but the highlight for many was excellent views of both Grey and Harbour Seals, allowing for direct comparison between the two species.

Overall, it was a thoroughly enjoyable day, taken at a relaxed pace and allowing plenty of time to appreciate both the stunning scenery and the wonderful wildlife.
