Day 1

Saturday 20th September

Clients departed Heathrow late morning for the direct flight to Kuala Lumpur, and then transferred to a shorter flight to Sandakan in Borneo.

Day 2

Sunday 21st September

The group arrived on time at Sandakan airport. Upon departure to Sepilok, they stopped at a sewage pond by the airport and managed to find Wandering Whistling Duck. The first 'proper' birding activity commenced one hour after check in. The group managed to see Plume-toed Swiftlet, Chestnut-bellied Malkoha, Little Heron, Rhinoceros and Black Hornbills and a few other species. We ended our day with dinner and a checklist update.

Day 3

Monday 22nd September

The group started their day with a 5.30am light breakfast and an early morning birding trip to the Rainforest Discovery Centre's (RDC) 620-metre Canopy Skywalk at 6.00am. Bird sightings in the morning were excellent; we had Bornean Bristlehead, Oriental Darter, Wallace's Hawk-Eagle, Diard's Trogon, Brown Barbet others before returning to the resort for a full breakfast.

After breakfast, we continued to the Sepilok Orangutan Rehabilitation Centre and the Bornean Sunbear Conservation Centre. Afternoon birding involved a second visit to the Rainforest Discovery Centre, and we covered the trail part this time, aiming for more c birds in the open area. The highlights were Stork-billed and Collared Kingfishers, Rufous-tailed Tailorbird and Oriental Magpie-Robin. On a night walk we managed to find a Philippine Slow Loris, Western Tarsier, Red Giant Flying Squirrel, and Hose's Pygmy Flying Squirrel.

Day 4

Tuesday 23rd September

The day started with birding at the RDC again; it was a bit quiet in terms of bird activity, but we managed to see Pink-necked Green Pigeon, Little Green Pigeon, Rufous-bellied Eagle, Grey-hooded Babbler and Bold-striped Tit-babbler, among others. We left Sukau at 10.00am, got stuck in heavy traffic for almost an hour due to an accident, and made a stop at a petrol station to use the facilities and shop for snacks.

The group arrived at Borneo Nature Lodge, Kinabatangan, at 1.00pm for lunch. The afternoon cruise started at 3.00pm, and we saw Bornean Elephant, Proboscis Monkey, Large Flying Fox, Lesser Adjutant, Oriental Pied, Bushy-crested and Wrinkled Hornbills, Sunda Crow, and others. After dinner, we went out for a night cruise, managing to spot roosting Black-and-red Broadbill, White-breasted Waterhen, Buffy Fish Owl, Striped Bronzeback snake, and Southern Palm Civet.

Day 5

Wednesday 24th September

The group had a light breakfast at 5.30am and went out for another trip at 6.00am in search of more birds. The morning cruise was delightful, with several sightings of Sunda Silvery Langur and many macaques. We were lucky enough to see the endangered Storm's Stork, Cinnamon Bittern, Common Iora, Brown Barbet, Crested Serpent Eagle, Crested Goshawk, Grey-headed and Lesser Fish-eagles, Oriental Dollarbird, Common Kingfisher, Blue-throated Bee-eater and others.

The afternoon started with a departure to Gomantong Forest Reserve at 2.30pm. We started by walking along the main road to the reserve, and managed to spot Banded Broadbill, White-crowned Shama, Black-naped Monarch and Chestnut-rumped Babbler. Upon arrival at the cave, we were greeted by an adult female Orangutan just a few metres away from us. Four clients went to the higher platform to experience the bat exodus, and while they were there, they saw Peregrine Falcon, Bat Hawk, Rufous-bellied Eagle, Oriental Pied Hornbill and, of course, millions of Malayan Free-tailed Bats exiting the cave.

Day 6

Thursday 25th September

The group headed out for another morning cruise before breakfast and saw our first pitta (Western Hooded), Bornean Blue Flycatcher, Chestnut-winged Cuckoo, Straw-headed Bulbul and others. We left Borneo Nature Lodge for Tabin Wildlife Reserve at 9.00am. En route, we stopped by the roadside near an oil palm mill, and on a pool there saw Sunda Teal and Common Moorhen.

The group arrived in Tabin at lunchtime after another heavy traffic delay, and we headed out for our first activity, which was a dusk drive. We located White-crowned and Bushy-crested Hornbills, Changeable Hawk-Eagle, Barn Swallow and White-crowned Shama. On the way back, we did some night spotting and saw another herd of Bornean Elephants, Leopard Cat, and a Blyth's Frogmouth.

Day 7

Friday 26th September

We started our day with an early breakfast and headed out to a road for birding. It was quite productive, and we saw a wild Orangutan, gibbons, and birds such as Great Slaty Woodpecker, Orange-backed, Grey-and-buff and Rufous Woodpeckers, Dusky Broadbill, Maroon-breasted Philentoma, and Black-crowned Pitta.

The afternoon was spent on the main road again, and we managed to see Sabah Partridge, Great Slaty and Crimson-winged Woodpeckers, and Ventriloquial Oriole. We went out for a night walk activity after dinner and the checklist update, and saw some stick insects, lantern bugs, Frilled Tree Frog and Buffy Fish Owl.

Day 8

Saturday 27th September

Today, the group went out to the Lipad Mud Volcano Trail. On our way, we stopped for birds spotted Striped Wren-babbler, Bold-striped Tit-babbler, Scarlet-rumped Trogon, Plaintive Cuckoo and Crested Honey Buzzard.

We went back to the resort for lunch, and headed out again on the main road and found Helmeted and Wreathed Hornbills, which completed the set of Borneo's hornbills nicely! In the evening, after dinner and a checklist update, we went out for a night drive and spotted three civet species and a Greater Indo-Malayan Chevrotain.

Day 9

Sunday 28th September

Early morning birding commenced around the main road before breakfast, with birds including Black-eared and Red-throated Barbets and White-bellied Erpornis, and gibbons. After breakfast we left Tabin at 9.00am, arriving at Lahad Datu airport at 10.30am to catch a 12.15pm flight to Kota Kinabalu. At the airport, we even managed to spot a Paddyfield Pipit. We arrived at Kota Kinabalu International Airport at 1.10pm and continued our journey to Kinabalu National Park. Arrival was at 4.00pm, and the group checked into the rooms with plans to do birding around 5.00pm, but we had to cancel due to rain.

Day 10

Monday 29th September

The group went out at 6.00am to go birding along the main road of Kinabalu National Park, starting with Bornean Treepie, Bornean Green Magpie, Chestnut-hooded Laughingthrush, Sunda Laughingthrush, the endemic Whitehead's Trogon and many others. After breakfast we continued birding around the park area in search of Whitehead's Broadbill before lunch. After lunch, we went out for more birding, but conditions were very misty and rainy, which made us cut our afternoon birding short and decide to have an early dinner and checklist update.

Day 11

Tuesday 30th September

This morning, the group went out to the Timpohon Gate with a van, and found birds such as Ashy Drongo, Whitehead's Broadbill, Mountain Blackeye, Pale-faced Bulbul and many more. We went back for breakfast and went out for another quick birding expedition before everyone went back to their room and got ready for check out and lunch. Those returning home caught their flight via Kuala Lumpur, and arrived safely back at Heathrow the next day.

Post-tour extension

Extension participants moved on to Mountain Valley Resort and took a little rest before coming back to Kinabalu National Park in the afternoon. The afternoon again featured thick mist, but we still found Red-breasted Partridge and both Indigo and Eyebrowed Jungle Flycatchers, among others.

Day 1

Wednesday 1st October

We went to the Crocker Range National Park in Tambunan district this morning, having departed from their accommodation at 4.30am to get to the Gunung Alab Birdwatching Point. Rewards included White-browed Shrike-babbler, White-throated Fantail, Bornean Leafbird, Bornean Bulbul, and Golden-naped Barbet. After spending a couple of hours here, we decided to take a one-hour journey to Trusmadi Forest Reserve where a bird hide is located, hoping to see a Bulwer's Pheasant. We were not lucky with the pheasant, but managed to get Crested Partridge, Orange-headed Thrush, Dayak Blue Flycatcher, Golden-whiskered and Bornean Barbets, and Long-billed Spiderhunter.

Day 2

Thursday 2nd October

We went for our final visit to Kinabalu National Park, and encountered plenty of bird activity. After breakfast, we decided to leave Kinabalu National Park early to spend some time birding around the Kota Kinabalu area lowlands and coastal areas. We visited Likas Lagoon and found White-winged Tern, a few egrets, Purple Heron and Oriental Darter. Then we continued to Tanjung Aru beach for Blue-naped Parrot, Brown-throated Sunbird, Green Imperial Pigeon and Whimbrel. The final stop before the airport was at Penampang Paddyfield area, where we scored our last birds, including Red-necked Stint, Wood and Common Sandpipers, Little Ringed Plover and Sunda Pygmy Woodpecker.

It was finally time to return to the airport for the long flight home, arriving next day.
